

MENTORING PROGRAM

Outdoor Excursions is a Christ-centered mentoring program that works with 5th – 8th grade students in our community. We recruit, select and train volunteers who go through a rigorous background check. All volunteers have made a commitment to disciple the students, provide guidance and encouragement and hopefully build lifelong relationship with them. We welcome students regardless if the youth find our program themselves, or they are referred to our program by school counselors, churches, foster program, or other social service agencies. The only requirement, the youth must express a desire to be mentored and be willing to make a commitment to attend the weekly meetings on a regular basis.



MISSION

The mission of Outdoor Excursions is to provide support to families by providing godly role models to youth. We accomplish this by mentoring/discipling youth to help them grow in their relationship with Jesus, grow in holiness, learn about their spiritual gifts and then exercise them in service to the body of Christ.

Our program seeks to counteract the negative influences and thoughts of worthlessness that so many youth have today. Through our discipleship program they will have the opportunity to participate in a variety of outdoor excursions that are designed to challenge them and help them grow in their faith in Christ Jesus.

Scheduled Trips

We mentor 5th – 8th grade students. We hope to either provide a godly role model for students that have not had one present in their life or reinforce the one(s) they already have.

WHAT DOES IT COST!

Trips are free, but regular attendance at weekly meetings is required. In the rare event, there is a cost associated with a trip, scholarships are available.
